HAVE A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD WITH COVID-19 RELATED SYMPTOMS	If you do not have any symptoms, you do not need to quarantine • Get tested 3–5 days after the exposure, even if you don't have symptoms (optional), unless the household member is tested* • Wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure	You may return to school if you remain symptom free AND the person with COVID-like symptoms tests negative for COVID-19*▽
HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT OF SOMEONE WITH COVID-19	If you do not have any symptoms, you do not need to quarantine • Get tested 3–5 days after the exposure, even if you don't have symptoms* (optional) • Wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure	You may return to school upon release from quarantine by the Tompkins County Health Department or local health department of residence*
TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19	You may return to school upon release from isolation by the Tompkins County Health Department or local health department of residence
